- Collaborate with Management Team (Project Lead/Project Manager) on project schedule, project roll-out, project timelines, project needs, project management and execution
- Develop daily work plans based on project blueprints, schedules, priorities, ensuring alignment with RenoLINC™'s quality standards
- Lead a Crew of 3-4 Team Members, assigning daily project tasks to execute project starts, oversee project from start to completion
- Monitor and maintain project schedule, adjusting tasks and resources to meet project deadlines
- Perform material take-offs
- Coordinate material with Project Lead/Manager to ensure all materials are ready daily for projects
- Coordinate with Trade Partners, Inspectors and to facilitate smooth project execution
- Liaison with Homeowner as needed to ensure they are informed and updated daily with project
- Operate tools and equipment, perform work as needed to support your Crew
- Ensure at all times project site is clean, organized, safe and hazard free
- Adhere to all Safety Protocols
- Conduct daily Safety Team Meetings
