- Complete your own Safety Protocol (daily) and Job Site Analysis (JSA) while on project site
- Ensure compliance will all building codes, client specifications
- Follow a Prep and Protect process to ensure the client's home is properly cared for from start of project to completion
- Provide project progress pictures, other requested documentation and weekly invoicing as requested
